2004 Corvette

Corvette production for the end of a generation, 2004, was slightly below previous years....34,064.... More customers wanted the newer body style than the 8 year old

C-5. Commemorative editions for coupe, convertible and Z06 were offered to honor the success of the C5R Racing program and to signal the end of the C-5 generation.

All commemorative editions had LeMans Blue exterior paint, crossed-flag embroidery on seat headrests, unique commemorative wheel centers and special silver front and rear emblems. The Z06 Model also had a unique carbon fiber hood weighing just 20.5 pounds. This was the first use of carbon fiber for a painted exterior panel in a North American production vehicle. You can lift a display model of the hood in the Corvette Museum and see for yourself just how light it is.
